

Global & Intercultural Engagement Honor Claim Form

Category 3: Foreign Language Learning and Proficiency

Candidates for the Global and Intercultural Engagement Honor can claim points in this Category in a variety of ways. The first is by taking courses at Western in a foreign language. Students will be awarded 20 points per 1.0 credit they complete. Students with functional fluency in a foreign language can prove it in a variety of ways: a) students whose first language is not English could attach a copy of their certificate of English proficiency used for Western admission, b) students could attach proof of graduation from a French Immersion Secondary school, c) students who have taken languages outside of Western could attach transcripts, certificate of completion, or verification letter. If you are unsure as to how to prove a language proficiency you would like to claim, please contact International Learning (intlearn@uwo.ca). Students may claim a maximum of 20 points per language and a maximum of 50 points in this Category.
